Wheelchair Ramp Construction Volunteer, Montrose CO –Ongoing opportunity (as needed)

Habitat for Humanity of the San Juans partners with several other organizations in the community to design and construct permanent wheelchair ramps for individuals who have lost mobility and cannot remain at home without a wheelchair ramp. Volunteers for this program should have experience in designing and constructing similar projects. Currently, we construct approximately one ramp per month. As a wheelchair ramp volunteer, you have the peace of mind and reassurance that your work is helping families remain in tact in their very own homes instead of having to live in a care facility and away from their families.

Family Advocate, Montrose CO –Ongoing opportunity (as needed)

You can be a part of the change you want to see in your community by volunteering with your local Habitat for Humanity of the San Juans. Family advocates walk alongside families who have partnered with Habitat for Humanity to construct a new home in order to ensure the family has all the tools and resources necessary to become successful homeowners. The Family Advocate is paired with and works with one individual family from the point of initial partnership until the family moves into their new home. Advocates are the first point of contact for assisting families in and work alongside Habitat staff on a regular basis. Advocates learn the processes and protocols of the organization well and have an opportunity to build a supportive partnership and important bond of trust with the families that can carry on for years to come. These individuals are often the closest to the family throughout the construction and purchasing process.
